2015 Strategic Planning Process:

- Reviewed 10 Community Health Needs Assessments (CHNAs) and 1
 Community Health Assessment (CHA)
- Matrix of needs and priorities
- Reviewed 10 Community Health Needs Assessment Implementation Plans and 1 Community Health Improvement Plan
- Mapped the implementation strategies within each plan using the Spectrum of Prevention framework

2015 Observations:

- None of the needs assessments included input from the general public via surveys, interviews, or focus groups
- ► The majority of recommended strategies centered on educating individuals and communities
- Very few of the strategies addressed policy, organizational practices or environmental barriers

2014 Southeast Fort Worth Community Conversations:

We're tired of people telling us how to eat healthier, when we don't have access to healthier food.

2015-2018 Strategic Plan:

Goal 1: Increase quality primary data for Tarrant County for Community Health Needs Assessments (CHNA) and grant applications.

2016-2017:

An Exploratory Study into Primary Data Collection for Community Health Needs Assessments in Tarrant County

- Studied how local hospitals implement the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 mandate that nonprofit hospitals conduct a community health needs assessment every three years, and develop an implementation strategy to meet the identified needs
- Reviewed the 2013-2014 CHNAs
- ► In-depth interviews with institutional leadership and key staff most closely involved with developing the CHNAs

Conclusions:

- Begin locally, think regionally
- Create a central advisory group
- Evaluate rigorously
- Provide a structure for collaborative implementation

Next Steps:

Working to develop a process that will include:

- ▶ Rolling data collection across 1/3 of Tarrant County annually
- Data sets can be grouped as needed for a specific institution or project region
